

The Didactive project is a European initiative aimed at enhancing digital and self–agency skills for vocational education and training (VET) to empower adults with low skills and education levels. Running from October 2024 to October 2026, Didactive is coordinated by En.A.I.P. Piemonte (Italy) and includes partners from France, The Netherlands, Greece, Austria, and Croatia.



Objectives

- Promote Self–Agency in VET by developing training and assessment methods to foster self–agency, helping adults make right decisions.
- Equip VET trainers, career advisors, and other experts with tools to improve their skills and support adults in self-agency and employability.
- Raise awareness within the VET system and among key players about the importance of creating conditions that allow individuals to exercise their self-agency.
